OSMC Outpatient Surgery Center Earns Joint Commission Accreditation

OSMC Outpatient Surgery Center has received notification from The Joint Commission accreditation program that it has earned a three-year accreditation with deemed status. This achievement reflects the Surgery Center's compliance with The Joint Commission's highest standards which better aligns with our mission to provide high quality care that is patient centered and focused on quality outcomes.

According to Marcy Grow-Dorman, Director of OSMC Outpatient Surgery Center, "The Joint Commission is the premier health care quality improvement and accrediting body in the nation. This accreditation is the outcome of an extensive examination of the Surgery Center's performance as it relates to orthopedic consultation, surgical procedures and post-operative follow-up care."

In just the past year, more than 5020 surgical and interventional pain management procedures were performed at the Surgery Center says Grow-Dorman. "This is a reflection of a nationwide trend – a growing number of patients choosing ambulatory surgical facilities for orthopedic surgery. Joint Commission's certification is validation that OSMC Outpatient Surgery Center is providing surgical patients with exceptional care.
