Leonard Kibiloski, MD receives recertification by ABOS

Elkhart- OSMC surgeon Leonard Kibiloski, M.D, was recently recertified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgeons (ABOS).

The American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery serves the public and medical profession by establishing standards for the education of orthopaedic surgeons. To be board certified physicians must pass both oral and written exams that evaluate his or her understanding of orthopaedics and its application in daily practice.

To maintain certification a physician must complete the recertification process every 10 years which includes an written exam as well as continuing medical education credits and case review.

Dr. Kibiloski joined OSMC in 1992 and specializes in total joint replacement, sports medicine, arthroscopic surgery, and general orthopedics. He is a fellow member of the American Association of Hip and Knee Surgeons. He is also a fellow of the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons.
